

Ancient Egypt PowerPoint

You will make a PowerPoint of at least 12 slides on Ancient Egypt. You will need to give information about these areas of Egyptian life:

- Title slide with Map of Ancient Egypt, your name, class period, and a title.
- Government – how Egypt was ruled and its most famous rulers
- Religion – Whom did Egyptians worship, how did they do so?
- Afterlife – What did Egyptians believe, and how did they prepare their pharaohs for it?
- Pyramids – What were they for, and for whom were they built?
- Women as leaders – Give information about two examples.
- SOURCES – you must list the websites you used. ZERO CREDIT will be given for Google or other search engines.
- PHOTOS: Each section must have one photo, and you must list the source of the photo. ZERO CREDIT will be given for Google or other search engines.

You will also need to get your PowerPoint reviewed by at least TWO other people. Three is preferred.
